Dr. Timothy Albert to Come to Duke as **DUCCS Visiting Professor**

Dr. Timothy Albert, who completed his Duke cardiology fellowship in 2006, will return to Duke campus March 13-14 as the DUCCS Visiting Professor. In 2015, Dr. Albert became the medical director of Tanner Medical Group, a multi-specialty network with over 30 locations in Georgia and Alabama.

Previously, he was the medical director for the Center for Advanced Diagnostic Imaging in Monterey, California, which he started in 2008.

Dr. Albert's time at Duke will include a visit to the Duke Cardiovascular Magnetic Resonance Center, meetings with fellows and faculty members, and a closed-door dinner where fellows can learn about Dr. Albert's career path and hold candid discussions about what happens after their fellowship.
